

Residential Program for Children with Mental Retardation Eligibility Criteria

Inclusionary Criteria

Potential residents who meet all of the inclusionary criteria listed below will be eligible for admission:

- Male or female
- Ages 5 – 22
- Can no longer live at home because of abuse, neglect, or abandonment
- Able to attend public school
- Emotional, Pervasive Development, and/or Mental Retardation Disorders

Exclusionary Criteria

Potential residents who meet one or more of the below criteria may be considered ineligible for admission:

- Predatory sexual tendencies
- Historically or currently chemically dependent
- Currently psychotic
- History of assaultive behavior towards others
- Attempted suicide within the last six months
- Expressed and acted on homicidal tendencies
- Set fires within the last year
- Diagnosed attachment disorders or other psychiatric problems (e.g. bi-polar disorders, post-traumatic disorders, depression, etc.)
- Primary Medical Needs
